Students produce designs for characters, environments, assets, creatures and storyboards, both in 2D and 3D, and in a simulated studio setting. Students develop skills in collaboration and creative design processes that will allow them to work effectively in the creative arts industry and produce work suitable for a portfolio that can assist them in further study or work applications. Certificate III in Information Technology (ICT30120) (Subsidised Training)	FULL Certificate <b>EOI and PART A REFERRAL FORM required (VETRO)</b>	Face-to-Face at TSC	This course provides skills and knowledge for students to become competent in a wide range of general information and communications technologies (ICT) and technical functions. The experience gained in this course enables students to achieve a degree of self-sufficiency as an advanced ICT user. A person with this certificate would have the skills to work effectively in an ICT environment and knowledge of critical, creative thinking skills, privacy policies and communicating with clients. They also develop skills to work safely in a building site. They will gain practical experience and develop specialist skills that gives them a competitive edge in the job market. These individuals carry out a range of basic procedural, clerical, administrative or operational tasks that require self-management and technology skills. This course will help students understand the role and responsibility of administration support.
